Code of Conduct

Professionalism

- I will set an excellent example of good sportsmanship by refraining from disputes with the umpires.
- I will not use profanity at any time.
- I will not smoke or chew tobacco in dugouts or on playing field at any time.

Safety- Pre-Game

- Parents of players who wear glasses should be encouraged to provide safety glasses
- Players must not wear watches, rings, pins, or metallic items during games and practices
- Should encourage the use of mouth guards?

Safety- During the Game and Practices

- No games or practice should be held when conditions are dangerous; inadequate lighting, bad weather especially lightening
- All Team equipment should be stored within the team dugout
- Only players, managers, coaches and umpires are permitted on the playing field or in the dugout during games and practice sessions.
- Batters must wear helmets at all times.
- Catchers must wear catcher's helmet, mask, throat guard, long model chest protector, shin guards and protective cup with athletic supporter at all times for all practices and games.
- Except when runner is returning to base, head-first slides are not permitted.

Safety- Around the Ball-Park

- Watch out for small children around parked and moving cars.
- Use Cross walks when crossing roadways always be alert for traffic.
- No playing in parking lots, No Climbing Fences, No Throwing Dirt
- No Glass containers, Alcohol in any parking lot, field, or common areas within a Nelson County Little Leagues complex.

Player Development

- I will adhere to all rules set out for my league.

Maintenance

- After each game, each team must clean up trash in dugout and around stands.
- No pets at Nelson County Little League games or Practices.

Conflict Resolution

- Parents or Fan talks with Coach

- League president - Attempts to resolve using Player agent, Rules Officer, Safety Officer or Board.

of players per team

- Teams will consist of no more than 12 players and no less than 10 players

Coach Selection

- Each team will be entitled to **one head coach** and **2 assistant coaches**
- Ranking for Coach Selection
 - Board members that help the league and do volunteer work.
 - Returning coaches if in good standing.
 - Coaches moving up to the league that have coaching experience and that are in good standing.
 - The league president will make the final decision on coach selection/determination when there is a question.

Game Duration

- Time limit will be 2 hours with no new inning starting with less than 7 minutes remaining

Team Selection

Initial Team Setup:

- Returning players who were selected through the draft will be put on the teams of returning coaches, players placed after the draft will return to the draft the following year if deemed to be in the best interest of the league.
- New coaches & assistant coaches kids will be put on teams.
- Returning players may request to be removed from a coaches team, however requests to be placed with specific coaches will not be honored, they will be placed in the draft. Likewise coaches may request to not have a returning player (not encouraged). All requests of this sort from parents, players or coaches must be in writing, via email or indicated on the registration form.
- No trades may be made without approval of the league president and all trades must be approved the night of the draft.
- 10 year olds requesting to play up will be placed in the draft as long as they played minor league the previous year. If undrafted they will be placed in the minor league draft.

Draft Rules:

- Each team must follow the +/- 3 rule
- The number of 12 year old players will be divided by the number of teams in the league. Each team must have within +/- 3 of this number of 12 year olds.

Example:

60 players

10 teams

$60 / 10 = 6$

Each team must have a minimum of 3 and maximum of 9 twelve year olds on each team

- All twelve year old players that sign up must play in major league - kid pitch

Draft Order:

- Each team will draw from a hat a selection number
- Selection will be from left to right until all teams have the same number of players
- When all teams have the same number of players then selection is from left to right and then right to left

Late Signups

- Late signups for 11 and 12 year olds will be reviewed prior to placement on a team, players will be placed on teams until all teams are full in the order that the forms come in using team draft order. Exceptions can be

made if deemed in the best interest of the league by the league president. (Example: a late registration arrives from a strong player and the team next in line to receive a player is already strong in the opinion of the league president, in cases like this the player will be placed where needed the most.

Game Rules

- Rules will be based on the Official Little League Rule book with no exceptions – unless noted
- Game results including score, winning and losing pitcher and pitch counts for all pitchers used in game shall be emailed by the head coach of both teams the night of the game to littleleague@bardstown.com so standings etc can be maintained and emailed to all coaches regularly.

Player Development Rules

- All players must occupy the batting order
- All players must play ½ of the total innings in the field
- The substitution rule will not apply (except for pitchers)

Fielding Rules

- 9 players will play in the field

- Team #1 is a new team with 1 coach and kid
- Team #2 is a returning team with 5 players returning
- Team #3 is a returning team with 4 players returning
- Team #4 is a new team with 2 coaches and kids
- Team #5 is a new team with 3 coaches and kids

Farm System Players

- 10 year old minor league players who are interested will be placed in a pool to be used when a major league team is in danger of be sort players. These players will be assigned by the league president and id assigned to a team must play in the game even if they are not needed to avoid a forfeit. Farm system players are not eligible to pitch when called up.

Boys Minor Player Pitch 9,10

of players per team

- Teams will consist of no more than 13 players and no less than 11 players

Coach Selection

- Each team will be entitled to **one head coach** and **2 assistant coaches**
- Ranking for Coach Selection
 - Board members that help the league and do volunteer work.
 - Returning coaches if in good standing.
 - Coaches moving up to the league that have coaching experience and that are in good standing.
 - The league president will make the final decision on coach selection/determination when there is a question.

Game Duration

- Time limit will be 1 hour 45 minutes with no new inning starting with less than 7 minutes remaining
- A new inning starts at the completion of the 3rd out of the previous inning
- Innings will be 3 outs

Team Selection

Initial Team Setup:

- Returning players selected through the draft will be remain on the teams of returning coaches. Players placed after the draft are subject to returning to the draft the following year if deemed in the best interest of the league.
- Returning players/teams with coaching vacancies will also remain together and a coach will be assigned to that team by the league president. Players placed after the draft are subject to returning to the draft the following year if deemed in the best interest of the league.
- Returning coaches may not switch coaches without returning the assistants child to the draft
- Returning players may request to be removed from a coaches team, however requests to be placed with specific coaches will not be honored, they will be placed in the draft. Likewise coaches may request to not have a returning player (not encouraged). All requests of this sort from parents, players or coaches must be in writing, via email or indicated on the registration form.
- No trades may be made without approval of the league president and all trades must be approved the night of the draft.
- 8 year olds requesting to play up will be placed in the draft as long as they played major machine pitch the previous year. If undrafted they will be placed in the major machine pitch draft.

Draft Order:

- Teams will be seeded by the league president in an effort to achieve as competitive a league as possible.
- The lowest seeded team will pick first and the highest last from the pool of players
- Once each team has selected a player in the first round then selection will be from left to right until all teams have the same number of players
- When all teams have the same number of players then selection is from left to right and then right to left

Late Signups

- Late signups for 9 and 10 year olds will be reviewed prior to placement on a team, players will be placed on teams in the order that the forms come in using team draft order until all teams are full. Exceptions can be made if deemed in the best interest of the league by the league president. (Example: a late registration arrives from a strong player and the team next in line to receive a player is already strong in the opinion of the league president, in cases like this the player will be placed where needed the most.

Game Rules

- Rules will be based on the Official Little League Rule book with no exceptions
- Game results including score, winning and losing pitcher and pitch counts for all pitchers used in game shall be emailed by the head coach of both teams the night of the game to littleleague@bardstown.com so standings etc can be maintained and emailed to all coaches regularly.

of players per team

- Teams will consist of a maximum of 13 players and a minimum of 11 players

Coach Selection

- Each team will be entitled to **one head coach** and **2 assistant coaches**
- Ranking for Coach Selection
 - Board members that help the league and do volunteer work.
 - Returning coaches if in good standing.
 - Coaches moving up to the league that have coaching experience and that are in good standing.
 - New Coaches
 - The league president will make the final decision on coach selection/determination when there is a question.

Game Duration

- Time limit will be 1 hour and 30 minutes
- New innings will not be started if less than 15 minutes remain
- A new inning starts at the completion of the 3rd out of the previous inning
- Complete innings will be played time permitting

Team Selection

Initial Team Setup:

- New coaches & assistant coaches kids will be put on team
- 7 year olds requesting to play up will be allowed to do so provided they played minor machine pitch the prior year as a 6 year old. If undrafted they will be placed in the draft for minor machine pitch.

Draft Rules:

- If brothers come into play then each team will be allowed additional players to make all teams equal
- Each team will draw from a hat a selection number
- Selection will be from left to right until all teams have the same number of players
- When all teams have the same number of players then selection is from left to right and then right to left

Draft Order:

- Each team will draw from a hat a selection number
- Selection will be from left to right until all teams have the same number of players
- When all teams have the same number of players then selection is from left to right and then right to left

Draft Complete:

- Trades will be allowed only on the day of the draft and must be approved by the league president

Late Signups

- Late signups will be placed on teams in draft order until all are full.

Game Rules

- Rules will be based on the Official Little League Rule book with no exceptions
- Game scores shall be emailed by the head coach of both teams the night of the game to littleleague@bardstown.com so standings etc can be maintained and emailed to all coaches regularly.

When Pitching Machine is used

- Machine speed will be 55-60 rpms
- Machine will be adjusted prior to each inning. Minor adjustments can occur during the inning but slowing down the game will not be allowed. (common sense should be used)
- Poor weather may warrant the umpire switching to coach pitch at anytime. At that time each team must identify the coach that will pitch to the players from that point on. The machine will be turned off and may not be used again during that game.
- When a batted ball strikes the machine the batter and all base runners shall be awarded one base.
- Players may steal 2nd or 3rd base, they cannot leave their current base in an attempt to steal until the ball crosses the plate. Players leaving early shall be returned to the original base by the umpire. Players must score on a batted ball, they may not steal home.

When Coach Pitch is used

- At that time each team must identify the coach that will pitch to the players from that point on (Just one coach or do we care? . The machine will be turned off and may not be used again during that game.

Player Development Rules

- All players must occupy the batting order
- All players must play ½ of the total innings in the field
- The substitution rule will not apply except for pitcher is used

Fielding Rules

- Pitcher must remain with both feet in the circle until the ball crosses the plate
- Runners may advance on hit balls or may steal 2nd or 3rd. (see above)
- Time will be called when the ball is in possession of an infielder
- 10 players will play in the field -
 - 4 outfielders, Left Fielder, Left Center Fielder, Right Center Fielder, Right Fielder, No rover
- All outfielders must play in the grass
- There will be no walks
- Coaches may not coach from the pitching machine (except for the batter). Coaching from the machine of any other players will result in a dead ball with all runners being sent back to the last base.
- Batters will receive a maximum of 6 pitches. If the 6th pitch is fouled they will get another. Umpires will call balls and strikes and players can be called out on strikes prior to receiving 6 pitches.
- Coaches must remain in the dugout while their team is playing defense.

Boys Major Machine Pitch 7

of players per team

- Teams will consist of a maximum of 13 players and a minimum of 11 players

Coach Selection

- Each team will be entitled to **one head coach** and **2 assistant coaches**
- Ranking for Coach Selection
 - Board members that help the league and do volunteer work.
 - Returning coaches if in good standing.
 - Coaches moving up to the league that have coaching experience and that are in good standing.
 - New Coaches
 - The league president will make the final decision on coach selection/determination when there is a question.

Game Duration

- Time limit will be 1 hour and 15 minutes
- New innings will not be started if less than 15 minutes remain
- A new inning starts at the completion of the 3rd out of the previous inning
- Complete innings will be played time permitting
- Games will last 6 innings. There will be a one hour and fifteen minute time limit.
- Innings will be 3 outs or 7 runs

Team Selection

Initial Team Setup:

- New coaches & assistant coaches kids will be put on team
- 6 year olds will be allowed to play up provided they played the prior year as a 5 year old in tball. If undrafted they will be placed in the pool for t-ball.

Draft Rules:

- If brothers come into play then each team will be allowed additional players to make all teams equal
- Each team will draw from a hat a selection number

- Selection will be from left to right until all teams have the same number of players
- When all teams have the same number of players then selection is from left to right and then right to left

Draft Order:

- Each team will draw from a hat a selection number
- Selection will be from left to right until all teams have the same number of players
- When all teams have the same number of players then selection is from left to right and then right to left

Draft Complete:

- Trades will be allowed only on the day of the draft and must be approved by the league president

Late Signups

- Poor weather may warrant the umpire switching to coach pitch at anytime. At that time each team must identify the coach that will pitch to the players from that point on. The machine will be turned off and may not be used again during that game.
- When a batted ball strikes the machine the batter and all base runners shall be awarded one base.
- Batters will receive 6 pitches unless they foul the 6th which then results in an additional pitch.

When Coach Pitch is used

- At that time each team must identify the coach that will pitch to the players from that point on (Just one coach or do we care? . The machine will be turned off and may not be used again during that game.

- Time will be called when the ball is in possession of an infielder
- 10 players will play in the field -
 - 4 outfielders, Left Fielder, Left Center Fielder, Right Center Fielder, Right Fielder, No rover

- All outfielders must play in the grass
- There will be no walks
- Coaches may not coach from the pitching machine (except for the batter). Coaching from the machine of any other players will result in a dead ball with all runners being sent back to the last base.
- Each batter will receive 6 pitches or 3 swinging strikes
- Foul balls on the last pitch will allow the batter an additional pitch
- Runners must be past ½ of the distance to the next base when time is called or will be sent back to the base they came
- 10 Players may play in the field but no more than 6 players may be in the infield.
- Runners may not advance on an overthrow to first base. (Runners may advance on an overthrow to any other base until the ball is under control in the infield)
- Pitcher must wear helmet with mask to protect from possible facial injuries??

Girls Minor Coach Pitch 7,8,9

players per team

- Teams will consist of no more than 13 players and no less than 12 players

Coach Selection

- Each team will be entitled to **one head coach** and **2 assistant coaches**
- Ranking for Coach Selection
 - Returning coaches if in good standing.
 - Board members that help the league and do volunteer work.
 - Coaches moving up to the league that have coaching experience and that are in good standing.

Game Duration

- Time limit will be 1 hour 45 minutes with no new inning starting with less than 7 minutes remaining
- A new inning starts at the completion of the 3rd out of the previous inning
- Innings will be 3 outs

Team Selection

Initial Team Setup:

- All 10 & 11 year olds must be placed on a team
- Any 9 year old requesting to play up should be honored
- Any 9 year old requesting to play down should be reviewed
- Returning players will be put on the teams of returning coaches
- New coaches & assistant coaches kids will be put on
- Returning coaches may not switch coaches without returning the assistants child to the draft
- Returning coaches may choose to return any player to the draft (this must be done prior to tryouts)
- All returning players must be drafted before new players in the league may be chosen

Draft Order:

- Each team will draw from a hat a selection number
- The lowest number team will pick first from the pool of players that played in the league the previous year
- Selection will be from left to right until all teams have the same number of players
- When all teams have the same number of players then selection is from left to right and then right to left

Draft Complete:

- Any 9 year old player not selected will be sent to the Major Machine Pitch

Late Signups

- Late signups for 10 and 9 year olds will be reviewed prior to placement on a team

Game Rules

- Rules will be based on the Official Little League Rule book with no exceptions

- Game scores shall be emailed by the head coach of both teams the night of the game to littleleague@bardstown.com so standings etc can be maintained and emailed to all coaches regularly.

Game Duration

- Games will last 6 innings. There will be a one hour limit.
- No innings will start with less than 15 minutes remaining .
- Complete innings will be played time permitting
- Innings will be 3 outs or 7 runs

- All Star nominations must be submitted to the league email address: littleleague@bardstown.com no later than May 15th each year (late nominations will not be accepted) . Teams will consist of a maximum of 15 players and a minimum of 11. All star ballots will due to littleleague@bardstown.com by May 31 (late ballots will not be accepted) Votes will be tallied and the top 8 players will be assigned to the team. If one of these 8 chooses not to or is unable to play then the next player in the voting will take their place. The head coach of the team shall fill the remaining roster spots at their discretion. Players who are selected to play on a state tournament team an opt not to play may not play on any other league sponsored post season team.
- State tournament teams will be provided uniforms by the league, all other post season teams will be responsible for their own uniforms. The league will cover the cost of the tournament entry fee for all little league sponsored post season tournaments.
